- •1. Nehemiah Faced Opposition from Without (4:1-9): Derision (vv. 1-3), Delay (vv. 7-8), and Deceit (6:1-3). Nehemiah's Decision: v. 9; Matt. 26:41
- 2. Nehemiah Faced Opposition from Within (4:10-5:19; Acts 20:29-30): Discouragement (4:10-17) and Dissatisfaction (5:1-19)
