The Four Dimensional Love of God in Ephesians 3:17-19

- ¹⁷ That Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may be able to comprehend with all the saints what *is* the width and length and depth and height—¹⁹ to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God.

1. God's Love Is Extravagant

John 3:16, "For God So Loved..."

1 John 3:18, "My little children, let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth."

1 John 3:1, "Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God!"

1. God's Love Is Extravagant (Cont.)

“Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins. ¹¹ Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another”
1 John 4:9-11.

“But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us” Romans 5:8.

2. God's Love Is Extensive

John 3:16, "For God So Loved The World..."

Matthew 5:43, "...Love Your Neighbor And Hate Your Enemy..."

Colossians 3:11, "There is no longer Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and free; but Christ is all and in all!"

1 John 2:15, "Love not the world..."

1 John 5:19, "The whole world lies under the sway of the wicked one."

2 Corinthians 4:14, "...the god of this world...."

Luke 23:34, "Father, forgive them for they do not know what they do."
