- **3. His Fatigue Replaced His Energy (1 Kings 18:46; 19:3, 4)**
- **4. His Frustration Replaced His Hope (1 Kings 19:10, 14; 1 Kings 18:4; 19:18, 4)**

## **2. The Relief For Elijah's Despair**

- **1. God Met His Physical Needs (1 Kings 19:5-7; 1 Kings 17:6, 16)**
- **2. God Met His Psychological Needs (1 Kings 19:18; Matthew 1:23; 28:20)**
- **3. God Met His Spiritual Needs (1 Kings 19:8-9; Exodus 33:21-22)**
