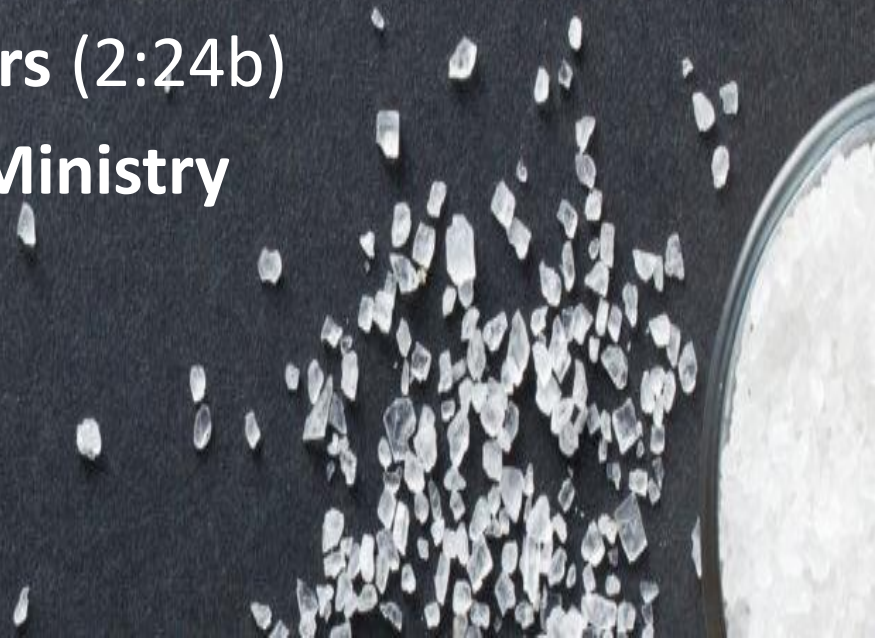


Elisha's Spring at Jericho
