Matthew 11:28-30

1. RECOGNIZE WHO JESUS INVITES

- “All”

- Mark 16:15; 1 Timothy 4:10; 2 Peter 3:9

- “You who labor”

- Romans 3:23; James 2:10; Luke 5:4-10

- “You who . . . are heavy laden”

- Matthew 23:2-4; Luke 13:14; Mark 2:16-17

2. APPRAISE WHAT JESUS OFFERS

- “I will give you rest”
 - John 9:1-41; John 10:7, 10-15
- “You will find rest for your souls”
 - John 4:4-42; Jeremiah 6:16

3. GRASP WHAT JESUS DEMANDS

- **“Take My yoke upon you”**
 - Deuteronomy 28:48; Matthew 16:24
- **“Learn from Me”**
 - Matthew 23:19-20; Luke 6:46-49
- **“My yoke is easy and My burden is light”**
 - Galatians 5:1; Acts 15:10; 1 John 5:3

4. CONSIDER HOW JESUS PERSUADES

- “Come to Me”
 - Matthew 23:37; 27:32; Exodus 21:6; Romans 6:16
- “I am gentle”
 - 2 Timothy 2:24-26; John 12:47; Matthew 26:52-53
- “I am . . . lowly in heart”
 - 2 Corinthians 8:9; Hebrews 2:14, 17-18; John 13:3-17; Philippians 2:5-8

NOW, WHAT WILL YOU DO WITH JESUS' INVITATION?

BE SAVED, BECOME A CHRISTIAN

- Hear the good news (John 1:1-3, 14; Romans 5:6-11)
- Believe it obediently (John 3:16; Hebrews 5:5-9)
- Repent of living in sin (Luke 13:3, 5)
- Confess your faith in Christ (Matthew 10:32-39; Romans 10:10)
- Obey the good news, be baptized (Acts 2:38; Romans 6:3-10)

REMAIN A SAVED CHRISTIAN

- Grow more faithful (Luke 19:17; 1 Corinthians 4:2; 1 Peter 2:21)
- Bear spiritual fruit (Galatians 5:22; 1 Peter 3:15)
- Be sound in doctrine (Romans 6:17; Titus 1:9)
- Be restored if unfaithful (2 Corinthians 7:10; 1 John 1:5-10)
